## PARISH COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

## 05.17.1 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

**NOTE:** Deputy Chairman Phil Suarez deputises as Chairman at the request of Chairman Nigel Dyson who was present at the meeting but felt unable to chair this due to ill health.

## 05.17.2 PREVIOUS MINUTES AND MATTERS ARISING THEREFROM

No matters arising - previous minutes agreed and signed as true by the Chairman of this meeting - Nigel Dyson.

## 05.17.3 FINANCIAL AUDIT 2016/2017

This is the last year under current regulations - external auditors will be no longer required but this years audit is strict. Review of internal controls required - income and expenditure schedule was presented and discussed. Expenditure listed as £3,151.00 - consists of mainly of end of year purchases. Agreements for outstanding cheques were honoured. Financial regulations remain very tight, quarterly reconciliations were signed as correct by Nick Claydon - Councillor.

## i. REVIEW EFFECTIVENESS OF THE 2016/17 INTERNAL CONTROLS

Felt to be effective by the external auditor - no concerns - Council received a robust positive review for the financial conduct in the year.

## iii. APPROVAL OF ACCOUNTS FOR 2016/17

Clarification on fixed assets were sought by External Auditor - figure calculated agreed

Councillors agree approval of accounts unanimously.

- i. RETROSPECTIVE APPLICATION WINDOWS @ RYECROFT -
  - Comments received from Councillors. Gallery informed that broadly whilst it seems unfair that this property should benefit from the improvements that are not approved when others with listed properties in the village are unable to make such improvements using the usual planning routes to application. It is however important to note that Councillors also believe that the planning laws governing listed properties are too stringent and do not allow for properties to become more energy efficient using a sympathetic alternative to single glazed wooden framed windows and doors.

Chairman asks all to consider alternative sites, although it a thought that this should be monitored for at the next pick and formulate a sensible plan on how to prevent this happening again.

## 05.17.7 RAVENS GREEN

i. **TRAFFIC SOLUTION** - Update and clarification on position of council who will support and put in application in for Ravens Greens residents but once again stressed that an agreement must be reached between the residents of the village before applications are made. Residents present confirmed that they would like to make an application to reduce speed limits and improve signage. It was reiterated that all residents must be in agreement. Residents meeting will be convened soon and PC once again confirmed that a representative from the Parish Council and possibly from County Council will be present. Residents present also advised that weight limits are generally ignored.

## **CRABTREE COTTAGE - update from Clerk on latest position.**

We have received a response from the council to the effect that a visit had been made and the site would be cleared of vehicles by the 21st April, it was noted that this has not really been done and Parish Council now awaits a council response on enforcement against Mr Smith.

It has been noted that Mr Smith is planting Lleylandi in the roadside of his boundary but the problem of the view from Ravens Green Resident homes remains.
